The City of Chester has a new trash and recycling contractor. On January 6, 2016, Chester City Council awarded local waste service company J. P. Mascaro & Sons a five-year, \$4.5 million contract to collect, recycle and dispose of City residential waste.

Serving a population of over 30,000 City residents, Mascaro will provide once a week curbside trash collection, as well as once a week curbside recycling services, beginning on January 7, 2016.
